God helps us, and we can help others. Count how many people would be helped if everyone helped two people.

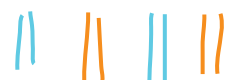
**Today:** I helped 2 people

**The fourth day:** Those 8 people each helped 2 people



**The fifth day:** Those 16 people each helped 2 people



How many people in all were helped in 5 days?  $2 + 4 + 8 + 16 + 32 = 62$

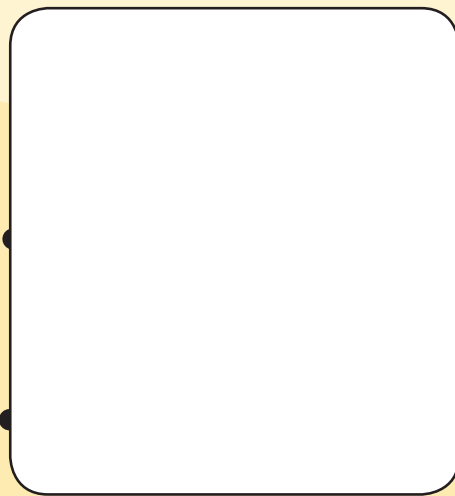
God had a special plan for Moses, even when he was a baby. Number the pictures in the correct order (1-6) to help tell others the story.



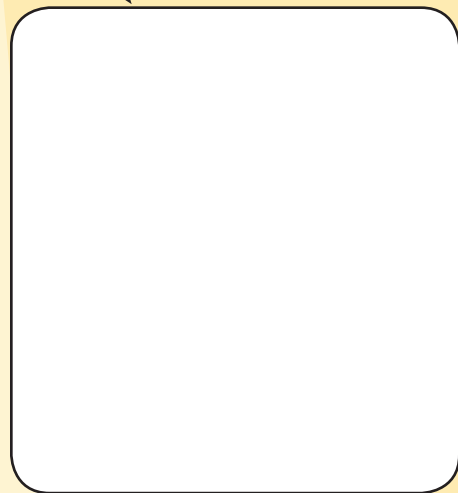
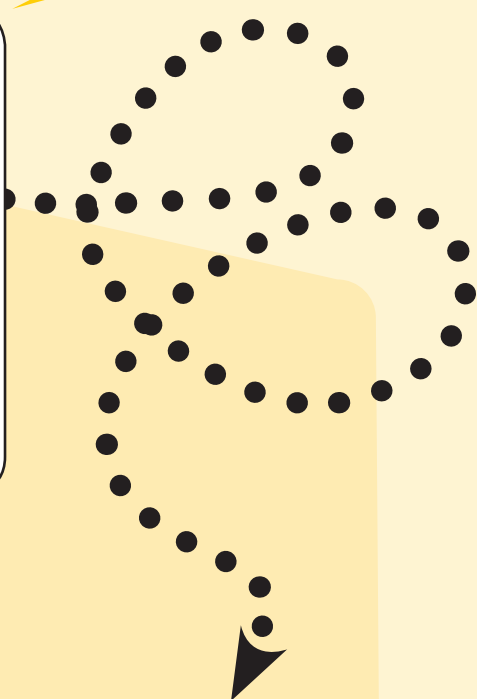
Today's Bible story, **Baby Moses**, is from the book of **Exodus**. Exodus is in the **Old Testament**. It is the second book of the Bible.

# Fill in the Faces

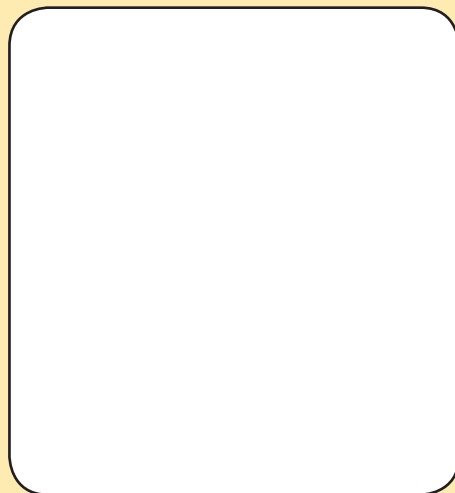

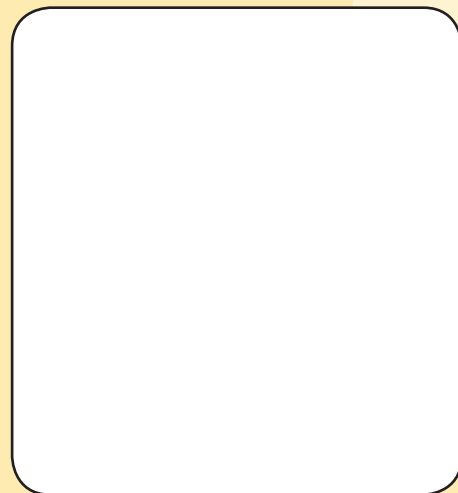
