Story Questions

Let's remember what God created. What are some things God made? Give families time to name parts of creation.

God created all the animals. What animals can you see on the page? Point to them! Give families time to point.

God created people too. Who created you?

Affirm that God has created all of us.

After God created the world, God rested. Who takes a nap in your family? Show me how you take a nap. Enjoy time where children and their caregivers show their nap positions.

Point out the statement at the end of the story: **God created you too!**

God created everything in the whole wide world. God created you too. God said that everything in creation was good. That means God says you are good! Say that to each other.

Give families a moment to face their children and say these words to them.
