


All About Babies



 and read! These activities boost a baby's brain development and help them learn about
 language and story.
- 3. A baby is born with more bones than adults. **TRUE**Babies are born with almost 300 bones. Adults have 206 bones. Where do all those bones go? As babies grow, some of their bones of the spine and skull fuse together.
