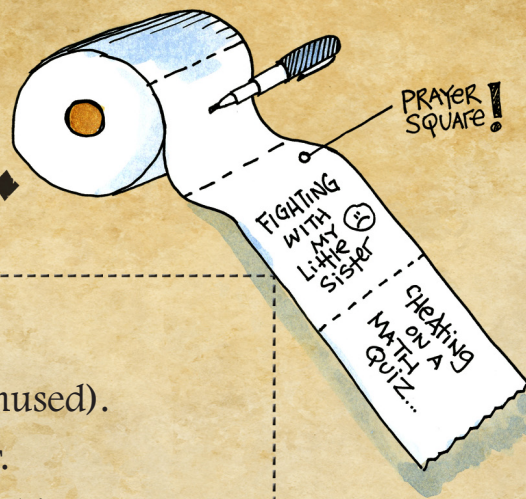
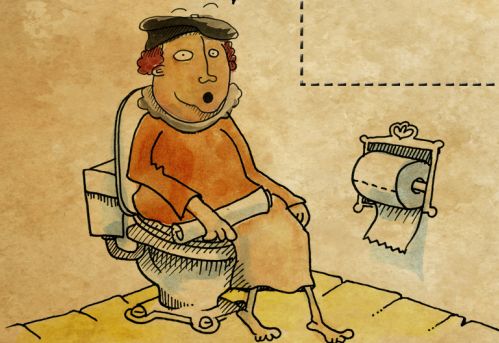


Here I Sit...
